Learning Objectives

Upon completion of the workshop, participants will:

- Understand the principles of pre-ERCP assessment including informed consent and management of comorbidities
- Understand alternative strategies to ERCP in the assessment of patients
- Describe safe intubation of the duodenum with the duodenoscope
- Understand the anatomy of the pancreaticobiliary tree
- Describe techniques of ERCP including principles of cholangiography and pancreatography, sphincterotomy, stenting and stone extraction.
