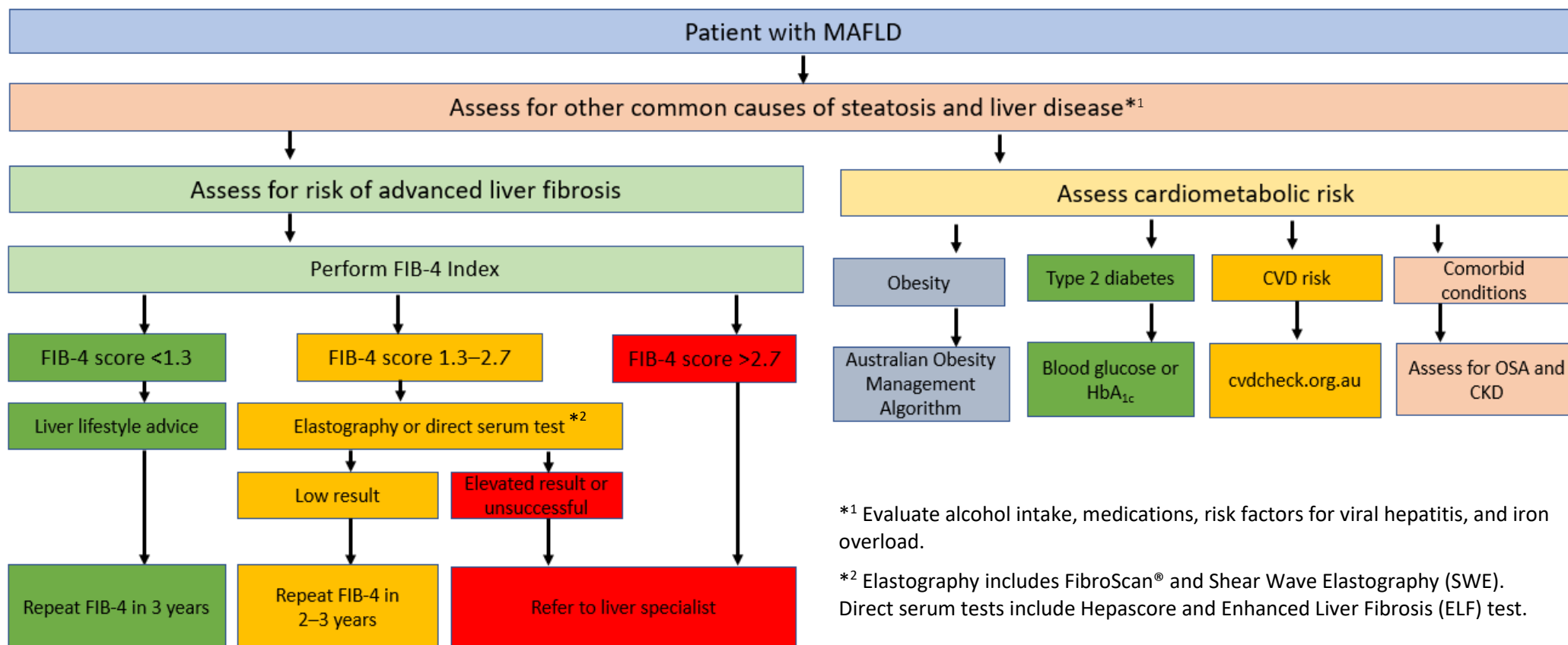


Assessment Algorithm for a Patient Presenting with MAFLD
